Desktop searches were carried out as follows.

One School – One School records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest show her residential details as s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest effective s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest 2021 and previously s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest from s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest 2020.

RPD – confirmed s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest was purchased in s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest 2020 in both parent's name s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest. A second large family home was also owned by the family, in s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest purchased s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest 2018.

During discussions with the mother s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest she advised that the s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest property was empty and that the family haven't lived there for some time and were thinking of selling it.

Observations were carried out on various days, at the s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest address and at all times it was evident that the s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest family were residing in the suburbs rather than within the LCA rental property at s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest.

Wednesday 6 October 2021

At 0630 am

Arrive in the vicinity of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest. On arrival the premises were confirmed to be a very large s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest at front, concrete driveway. The property looked to be well kept and well maintained, with established lawns, gardens and hedges at front.

Parked at the front of the house on the nature strip was a s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest and parked on the driveway was a white s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest registered s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest.

At 6.45 am

Whilst taking up a position to observe departure of the vehicles, vehicle s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest departed the area from the nature strip, the driver was observed to be a male and appeared to be travelling alone.

At 8.07 am

The double remote garage was now raised.

At 8.11 am

A young male approx s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest was observed to exit the garage and walk to the side of vehicle s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest from view.

At 8.13am

A female believed to be s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest walked from the garage to the drivers side of vehicle s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest where she proceeded to enter the vehicle.

At 8.14am

The vehicle was reversed from the driveway and the garage closed. As the vehicle passed my position there appeared to be other children in the vehicle.

The vehicle was followed.

At 8.33am

The vehicle arrived at the s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest drop off zone on s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest. Although partly obscured from view, there appeared to be three children exit the vehicle.

The vehicle was not followed, however I departed for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest the address known to be the workplace of both parents, and s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest business.

At 9.20 am

I arrived at the s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest workplace at which time vehicles s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest (observed earlier at s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest premises) and s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest were observed to be parked on the vacant land adjacent to the business.

Thursday 7 October 2021

At 6.45 am

Arrive in the vicinity of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest

On arrival there were no vehicles parked at front and the premises was in a closed state with the garage door closed.

At 8.03 am

The garage door was raised and vehicle s.47(3)(b) was reverse parked inside the garage. Both front doors of the vehicle were open and a s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest years of age was standing in the garage.

At 8.05 am

A female believed to be s.47(3)(b) was observed to walk across the front of the vehicle towards the side of the inside of the garage, where she appeared to take something from a shelf. s.47(3)(b) then returned across the vehicle to the drivers side and entered the vehicle.

At 8.06am

A young girl wearing a s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest uniform, believed to be s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest walked from the house across the front of the vehicle, before entering the passenger side of the vehicle

At 8.07am

The vehicle departed the premises and the garage door was closed.

The vehicle was followed towards s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest

At 8.27am

Vehicle s.47(3)(b) was parked outside the s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest drop off zone on s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest and the children exited the vehicle and walked from view inside the school.

Friday 8 October 2021

At 6.45 am

Arrive in the vicinity of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest

On arrival there were no vehicles parked at front and the premises was in a closed state with the garage door closed.

At 8.03am

A young girl approximately s.4yo was standing at the rear of the vehicle dressed in a s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest uniform and looking at a shelf in the corner of the garage that was observed to have an assortment of shoes on it.

At 8.12am

A female believed to be s.47(3)(b) walked around the back of the vehicle towards the drivers door.


The young girl believed to be s.47(3)(b) walked back across the vehicle carrying a large purple stuffed toy.

At 8.13am

Vehicle s.47(3)(b) departed the premises, however was not followed.

Two wheelie bins were located at the front side of the premises, with the recycling bin overflowing with cardboard.

I refer to the recent application to enrol your daughter, s.47(3)(b) at Brisbane State High School ('the school').

My preliminary view

This letter is to advise you that I have formed a preliminary view that s.47(3)(b) is not eligible to enrol at Brisbane State High School.

Preliminary material considered

In considering this enrolment application, I considered the following preliminary material:

- Your application for s.47(3)(b) for Local Catchment Area enrolment, dated s.47(3)(b) 2021;
- Preceding communication with our Enrolments Office, by way of local catchment pre-enrolment interview on s.47(3)(b) 2021 and further telephone conversation;
- The effective School Enrolment Management Plan (School EMP) and catchment map for Brisbane State High School;
- The Department's School EMP procedure and operational guidelines;
- Chapter 8, Part 3 of the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006 (the Act);
- OneSchool records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest regarding residential address, enrolment activity, and other relevant information;
- Outcomes from an ongoing investigation that independently assess and validate information that you supplied in your enrolment application; and,
- Property Data from RP Data Professional.

My preliminary findings of fact

In consideration of the preliminary material, I made the following findings of fact:

1. OneSchool records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest show that she is currently enrolled at s.47(3)(b) - State School, and has been since Year s.47(3)(b) - Contra and previously s.47(3)(b) to Year s.47(3)(b) - State School. These schools are not within the boundaries of our catchment area, nor are they recognised feeder schools for our local area enrolments. That raises doubts as to the validity of your application for in-catchment enrolment.
2. Furthermore, OneSchool records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest show her residential and postal details as:
 - s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest South Brisbane, 4101, effective s.47(3)(b) 2021, previously;
 - s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest effective from s.47(3)(b) - Co 2020.

OneSchool records show both parents residential address as s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest South Brisbane, 4101 and previously s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Pu

3. You have provided evidence that demonstrates that you have recently leased a property within the local catchment area, [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest] South Brisbane, 4101. This is not the same as being able to demonstrate, via submitted evidence that [s.47(3)(b)] principal place of residence is within our catchment boundaries. It is reasonable to assume that you have nominated the property at [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest] South Brisbane, 4101, for the purpose of Local Catchment Area enrolment, given that it is a smaller unit within a busy unit complex, rather than a much larger family home.
4. Further to this, I have doubts as to the validity of the evidence you have presented regarding your other residence, [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest] as being empty and unoccupied. Real estate searches show you purchased the premises in [s.47(3)] 2020 and updated OneSchool Records September 2020. Investigative outcomes have revealed:
 - [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest] South Brisbane, is a unit with one car space, in a busy complex; leased [s.47(3)] 2021 to [s.47(3)] 2022 in joint names of both parents;
 - [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest]
[s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest]
[s.47(3)(b)] purchased [s.47(3)] 2020 in joint names of both parents [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest]
 - [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest] is a recent address recorded on OneSchool for
 - Sightings of two motor vehicles parked at the premises of [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest]
[s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest] either in garage, driveway or roadside at front of house:
 - Vehicle [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest] wagon, registered for private use; in the name of [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest] no documents were provided for this vehicle, however [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest] drives the children to school in this vehicle from [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest]
 - Vehicle [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest] Sedan, registered for private use; no documents were provided for this vehicle, however it was observed to be parked at the front of [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest] and at the nominated workplace on the application for both parents, [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest]
 - You provided a Budget Direct insurance document for a [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest] sedan registration [s.47(3)(b)] that states the usual location to be parked at [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest] South Brisbane. The document shows that the vehicle is insured in both parents' names and registered in the surname [s.47(3)] This vehicle was sighted at the workplace, [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest]
 - Sightings of all [s.47(3)(b)] members of the family departing the [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest] premises on various weekday mornings, in the abovementioned vehicles, with [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest] children in [s.47(3)(b)] State School uniforms.

In addition, you advised your intention is not to enrol [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest] siblings at the local West End School, rather for them to continue at [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest] State School.

Furthermore, OneSchool records note that [s.47(3)(b)] has a future enrolment at [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest] State High School effective [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest] 2021 at which time the address given was [s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest]

5. As stated within the school's EMP, I reserve the right to undertake an audit or conduct an investigation at any time to ensure compliance with the EMP requirements; false or misleading statements or assertions amount to an offence and will have impact on an application for enrolment.
6. I am satisfied that there is no other relevant provision of the school's EMP which would apply to deem [s.47(3)(b)] eligible for enrolment at the school.
7. There is currently no spare capacity to accept out of catchment enrolments.

Reasons for my preliminary view

I have formed my preliminary view for the following reasons:

- To enrol at Brisbane State High School an applicant must be eligible in accordance with the school's EMP;
- False or misleading statements of assertions amount to an offence and will have impact on an application for enrolment;
- No other part of the school's EMP applies so as to render s.47(3)(i) eligible to be enrolled.
- Accordingly, s.47(3)(i) is not eligible to enrol at the school.

You may respond to this preliminary view by making a written submission to me, no later than seven days after receiving this letter.

If no submission is received, my preliminary view will be treated as the final decision and no further notice will be provided.

If a submission is received, I will consider the submission and make a final decision. A final decision notice will be provided to you to confirm the outcome as soon as is practicable.

Good afternoon Mr and Mrs s.47(3)(b)

I am writing on behalf of the Executive Principal. I refer to the emailed communication on 3 November 2021, where Mr Haynes outlined his preliminary view that s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest was not eligible to enrol at Brisbane State High School. As per our current Enrolment Management Plan, and as advised on 3 November 2021, you had the option of providing a written submission to the preliminary view no later than seven (7) days after receiving this letter.

As we have received no communication in response, I am now writing to confirm that the Executive Principal's preliminary decision is to now be treated as the final decision. We are unable to offer enrolment for your daughter, s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest via local catchment. No other part of the School's Enrolment Management Plan applies so as to render s.47(3)(b) eligible for enrolment.

As per the Enrolment Management Plan, there is no internal review of the Executive Principal's decision.

One School – One School records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest show her residential details as s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest active from s.47(3)(b) - 2014 with a future enrolment at s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest State High School effective s.47(3)(b) - 2021.

RPD – confirmed s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End, is a small 2-bedroom unit with one car space, purchased in 2003, in the name of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest (Parent: s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest).

s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest is located in a residential area on a one-acre block and is s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest garages. This property is jointly owned in the name of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest and s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest (Grandparents of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest) purchased in 2003, prior to building of the very large family home.

Parent s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest also advised that he attends work from home at s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest Minimal documentation was provided for the LCA address in West End as parent advised most documents were addressed to s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest for work purposes, however drivers licenses had recently been changed to West End address.

Observations were carried out on various days, at the s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest address and at all times it was evident that the s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest family were residing in the suburbs rather than within the LCA.

Tuesday 17 August 2021

At 0630 am

Arrive in the vicinity of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest On arrival the premises were confirmed to be a very large s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest and a brick and fence across the front of the property. RPD searches showed many multi million dollar houses within the estate. The property looked to be well kept and well maintained, with established lawns and gardens.

Parked at the front of the house to the left of the front entrance was a s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest registration later confirmed to be s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest and parked at the entry obscured from view was a s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest.

At 8.06 am

The large double gate opened and soon after vehicle s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest departed the property with a male driving and unidentified passengers in the back seat, I proceeded to follow the vehicle.

At 8.20 am

The vehicle was observed to turn left onto s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest from s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest at which time two children were observed to be in the back seat of the vehicle.

The vehicle was followed to the s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest drop off zone, but due to traffic conditions was not immediately followed.

Thursday 19 August 2021

At 6.30 am

Arrive in the vicinity of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public

On arrival parked at the front of the house to the left of the front entrance was a s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public and parked at the entry obscured from view was a s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public

A Wheelie Bin was located on the front kerb in close proximity to the front gate. Neighbouring premises also had their wheelie bins on the kerbside.

At 8.10 am

While carrying out a walk by of the front gate, the back door of the s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public was observed to be raised. Two young girls dressed in s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public SS uniform were observed walking towards the vehicle with school bags that they placed in the rear of the vehicle, they stood at the vehicle for a few minutes talking and re arranging items in the back of the car.

At 8.13 am

The girls were observed to close the rear door of the vehicle and I returned to my vehicle in anticipation of them departing the premises.

At 8.15

The vehicle departed the premises and was again observed to be travelling towards s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public SS. Contact was lost due to traffic conditions, however the vehicle was later observed on s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public SS and soon after turned right towards the s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public SS

Friday 27 August 2021

At 7.00 am

A spotcheck was carried out at s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public at which time both vehicles previously observed were in attendance the s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public at the front entry and the s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public parked to the left of the house.

Tuesday 26 October 2021

At 6.45 am

Arrived in the vicinity of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public at which time only the s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public at the front entry was observed to be in attendance. The double gate was closed.

At 8.53 am

A male believed to be s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public appeared at the front letterbox area where he collected mail and returned inside the premises.


With no further activity or sighting of the s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public I departed the area.

I refer to the recent application to enrol your daughter s.47(3)(b) at Brisbane State High School ('the school').

My preliminary view

This letter is to advise you that I have formed a preliminary view that s.47(3)(b) is not eligible to enrol at Brisbane State High School.

Preliminary material considered

In considering the enrolment application, I considered the following preliminary material:

- Your application for s.47(3)(b) for Local Catchment Area, dated s.47(3)(b) 2021;
- Preceding communication with our Enrolments Officer, by way of local catchment pre-enrolment interview on s.47(3)(b) 2021 and, telephone conversation thereafter;
- The effective School Enrolment Management Plan (School EMP) and catchment map for Brisbane State High School;
- The Department's School EMP procedure and operational guidelines;
- Chapter 8, Part 3 of the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006 (the Act);
- OneSchool records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest regarding residential address, enrolment activity, and other relevant information;
- Outcomes from an ongoing investigation that independently assess and validate information that you supplied in your enrolment application; and,
- Property Data from RP Data Professional.

My preliminary findings of fact

In consideration of the preliminary material, I made the following findings of fact:

1. OneSchool records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest show that she is currently enrolled at s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest State School, and has been since year s.47(3)(b). This school is not within the boundaries of our catchment area, nor is it a recognised feeder for our local area enrolments. This raises doubt as to the validity of your application for in-catchment enrolment.
2. Furthermore, OneSchool records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest show her residential details as:
 - s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest active from s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest 2014.

OneSchool records show both parents residential address as s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest with no change of address since s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest 2014. It is reasonable to assume, that if there had been any change to s.47(3)(b) principal place of residence you would have advised s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest State School with an update of both her and of your change of residential address.

In addition, OneSchool records note that s.47(3)(b) has a future enrolment at s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest State High School effective s.47(3)(b) 2021. It is also noted that you advised us that you applied to Brisbane

South State Secondary College, however, were declined an offer of enrolment. Once again, this raises doubt as to the validity of your application for in-catchment enrolment for Brisbane State High School.

3. You have provided evidence which demonstrates that you own a property within the catchment; s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End, 4101. This is not the same as being able to demonstrate, via submitted evidence that s.47(3)(b) principal place of residence is within our catchment boundaries. It is reasonable to assume that you have nominated the property at s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End, 4101, for the purpose of Local Catchment Area enrolment.
 4. Further to this, I have doubts as to the validity of the evidence you have presented regarding your property within the local catchment (i.e. s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End) and the long term residential address recorded on OneSchool for your family (i.e. s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest). Investigative outcomes have revealed:
 - s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End, is a small 2-bedroom unit with one car space, purchased in s.47(3)(b) in the name of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest.
 - s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest is located in a residential area on s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest and is very close to s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest. This property is jointly owned in the name of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest and s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest purchased in s.47(3)(b) prior to building of the very large family home.
 - s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest is a long-term family home, being the only address recorded on OneSchool for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest.
 - s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest is the address you informed the school of as your workplace, that being your own business. Further to this, you advised the school that this is your parents' house, whom you have previously lived with long-term.
 - Sightings of two motor vehicles: s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest regularly parked at the premises of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest at the front of the house behind the closed gate:
 - You initially provided no documents for motor vehicle registration or insurance to evidence your local address, rather advised that the vehicle you drive is registered in the business name or your parents name at s.47(3)(b). However, you later provided registration and insurance documents for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest and s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest, sighting this as being the vehicle of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest. Additionally, you confirmed that you owned a s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest however it was written off in an accident in early s.47(3)(b) 2021.
 - Sightings of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest departing the premises on various weekday mornings, in the vehicle s.47(3)(b) with the children in their s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest State School uniform.
 - s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest informed the school that he drives s.47(3)(b) to school each day departing early for extracurricular activities, before proceeding to s.47(3)(b) for work. However, there have been no sightings of your family departing the vicinity of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End, on school mornings.
- Furthermore, the minimal documentation that you provided upon submission of the enrolment application, including low electricity for a family of four and minimal nominated contents insurance, support my belief that your family are continuing to reside at s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest. It is my belief that you are presenting evidence that is intentionally designed to mislead our determination of s.47(3)(b) principal place of residence to gain enrolment via local catchment.
5. As stated within the school's EMP, I reserve the right to undertake an audit or conduct an investigation at any time to ensure compliance with the EMP requirements; false or misleading statements or assertions amount to an offence and will have impact on an application for enrolment.
 6. I am satisfied that there is no other relevant provision of the school's EMP which would apply to deem s.47(3)(b) eligible for enrolment at the school.
 7. There is currently no spare capacity to accept out of catchment enrolments.

Reasons for my preliminary view

I have formed my preliminary view for the following reasons:

- To enrol at Brisbane State High School an applicant must be eligible in accordance with the school's EMP;
- False or misleading statements of assertions amount to an offence and will have impact on an application for enrolment;
- No other part of the school's EMP applies so as to render s.47(3) eligible to be enrolled;
- Accordingly s.47(3) is not eligible to enrol at the school.

You may respond to this preliminary view by making a written submission to me, no later than seven days after receiving this letter.

If no submission is received, my preliminary view will be treated as the final decision and no further notice will be provided.

If a submission is received, I will consider the submission and make a final decision. A final decision notice will be provided to you to confirm the outcome as soon as is practicable.

I refer to my preliminary view letter dated 3 November in relation to the enrolment application for your daughter, s.47(3)(b) - Contr at Brisbane State High School ('the school'). Thank you for your response. I have considered the information that you submitted on 9 November 2021 with the school's response outlined below.

Enrolment Management Plans (EMPs) are developed by the Department of Education and Training and it is my obligation as the Executive Principal to implement and administer the EMP. Our Enrolment Management Plan was reviewed by the Department as the school is over capacity as families decide they want their child/ren to attend our school and therefore move from other areas of Brisbane to our local catchment. We acknowledge we are a great school; however, we are required to tightly manage enrolments at our school.

When you first approached our school, we were clear in informing you that our school was currently over capacity and that the demand for enrolment far exceeds the positions available in each year level. There was also reference made to the statement that, "parents considering enrolling their child at BSHS must understand that an application for enrolment does not guarantee confirmation of a place".

As has been previously communicated to you, the school requires the provision of documentary evidence to sufficiently demonstrate that the address stated on the enrolment application is the student's principal place of residence. The issue of whether a residence is a student's principal place of residence will be determined at my discretion, with the relevance and weight of each factor dependent on the individual circumstances of each case. After consideration of your existing enrolment package and the additional documentation that you provided, further findings of fact are outlined below.

My final decision

I have decided that s.47(3)(b) - Contr is not entitled to enrolment at Brisbane State High School in accordance with section Chapter 8, Part 3 of the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006 (the Act), and in accordance with the school's Enrolment Management Plan (School EMP).

Final decision materials considered

In making my decision, I considered the following material:

- Your application for Fiona for Local Catchment Area, dated s.47(3)(b) 2021;
- Statutory declaration made by s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public at s.47(3)(b) - Contra on s.47(3)(b) 2021 regarding the residential address of s.47(3)(b) - Cor

- Preceding communication with our Enrolments Officer, by way of local catchment pre-enrolment interview on s.47(3)(b) 2021 and, telephone conversation thereafter;
- The effective School Enrolment Management Plan (School EMP) and catchment map for Brisbane State High School;
- The Department's School EMP procedure and operational guidelines;
- Chapter 8, Part 3 of the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006 (the Act);
- OneSchool records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest regarding residential address, enrolment activity, and other relevant information;
- Outcomes from an ongoing investigation that independently assess and validate information that you supplied in your enrolment application;
- Property Data from RP Data Professional; and,
- Your response to my preliminary view letter dated 9 November 2021.

Reasons for my final decision

As stated within our current Enrolment Management Plan, parents who seek to enrol their child at the school will need to fully demonstrate that the student's principal place of residence is genuinely within the catchment area. Current proof of residency at the address indicated on the enrolment application must be provided.

As per my preliminary findings on 3 November 2021:

- I acknowledge that s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest owns a residence within our catchment boundaries; this does not support the determination of s.47(3)(b) principal place of residence as per enrolment eligibility requirements.
- I retain the belief that you consciously provided selected documentary evidence and misleading information within the enrolment application with the intended effect of meeting enrolment eligibility requirements.
- OneSchool records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest show her residential details as s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest active from s.47(3)(b) - 2014 – updated to s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End, 4101, on s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest 2021.
- OneSchool records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest show that she is a future student with s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest State High School and s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest State High School. It is reasonable to assume that you have undertaken these additional enrolment processes, as you are not eligible for local catchment enrolment at Brisbane State High School.

The EMP specifically states that, as Executive Principal, I "reserve the right to undertake an audit or conduct an investigation at any time to ensure compliance with the requirements under this Enrolment Management Plan and an entitlement to enrol". Temporarily residing, leasing and/or owning a property within our catchment is not the same as being able to demonstrate a student's principal place of residence, as per our current EMP. The evidence you have submitted provided does not assist in determining that Fiona is eligible to enrol at our school through local area catchment.

While your submission shows that you own a 2-bedroom property within our catchment boundaries (i.e. s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End), you have not been able to sufficiently prove this address as s.47(3)(b) principal place of residence as per our current Enrolment Management Plan. I have been consistent in explaining that, as the Executive Principal, I am required to undertake stringent consideration of all applications to be considered for enrolment via local catchment, and I do not make such decisions lightly.

In considering additional information you have provided on 9 November in response to the opportunity to forward evidencing documentation to meet eligibility for a local enrolment application and, based on the balance of probability, my final decision is that I am unable to offer enrolment for s.47(3)(b) via local catchment. No other part of the School's Enrolment Management Plan applies so as to render s.47(3)(b) eligible for enrolment.

Pursuant to sections 156(1) and 171 of the Act and in accordance with the School EMP, I have made the decision that s.47(3)(b) - Contr is not entitled to enrolment at Brisbane State High School for the following reasons:

- Section 156(1) of the Act provides that, "*Subject to subsections (1A), (2) and (3), the principal must enrol the prospective student at the school if the prospective student is entitled under this Act to be enrolled at the school*". Based on the material before me, I am not satisfied that s.47(3)(b) - Contr is entitled under the Act to be enrolled at the school.
- Section 171 of the Act and the School EMP provides that a person is entitled to be enrolled if their principal place of residence is in the school's catchment area. I am not satisfied based on the material before me that s.47(3)(b) - Contr principal place of residence is within the school's catchment area.
- Accordingly, it is my decision that s.47(3)(b) - Contr is not entitled to enrolment at Brisbane State High School, as she does not reside in the catchment and none of the other criteria for enrolment that apply to those who reside outside the catchment area would have applied in their circumstances.
- There is currently no spare capacity to accept out of catchment enrolments.

The School EMP provides that my decision is final. There is no internal review available of my decision.

Thank you again for your interest in Brisbane State High School. I wish s.47(3) well in her educational journey.

I refer to the recent application to enrol your daughter, s.47(3) at Brisbane State High School ('the school').

My preliminary view

This letter is to advise you that I have formed a preliminary view that s.47(3) is not eligible to enrol at Brisbane State High School.

Preliminary material considered

In considering the enrolment application, I considered the following preliminary material:

- Your application for s.47(3) for Local Catchment Area, dated s.47(3)(b) 2021;
- Preceding communication with our Enrolments Officer, by way of local catchment pre-enrolment interview on s.47(3)(b) 2021 and, telephone conversation thereafter;
- The effective School Enrolment Management Plan (School EMP) and catchment map for Brisbane State High School;
- The Department's School EMP procedure and operational guidelines;
- Chapter 8, Part 3 of the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006 (the Act);
- OneSchool records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest regarding residential address, enrolment activity, and other relevant information;
- Outcomes from an ongoing investigation that independently assess and validate information that you supplied in your enrolment application; and,
- Property Data from RP Data Professional.

My preliminary findings of fact

In consideration of the preliminary material, I made the following findings of fact:

1. OneSchool records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest show that she is currently enrolled at s.47(3)(b) - C State School, and has been since year s.47(3)(b) 2014. This school is not within the boundaries of our catchment area, nor is it a recognised feeder for our local area enrolments. This raises doubt as to the validity of your application for in-catchment enrolment.
2. Furthermore, OneSchool records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest show her residential details as:
 - s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest active from s.47(3)(b) - C 2014.

OneSchool records show both parents residential address as s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest with no change of address since s.47(3)(b) - C 2014. It is reasonable to assume that if there had been any change to s.47(3)(b) principal place of residence you would have advised s.47(3)(b) - C State School with an update of both her and of your change of residential address.

In addition, OneSchool records note that s.47(3) has a future enrolment at s.47(3)(b) - C State High School effective s.47(3)(b) 2021. It is also noted that you advised us that you applied to Brisbane

South State Secondary College, however, were declined an offer of enrolment. Once again, this raises doubt as to the validity of your application for in-catchment enrolment for Brisbane State High School.

3. You have provided evidence which demonstrates that you own a property within the catchment; s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End, 4101. This is not the same as being able to demonstrate, via submitted evidence that s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest principal place of residence is within our catchment boundaries. It is reasonable to assume that you have nominated the property at s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End, 4101, for the purpose of Local Catchment Area enrolment.
4. Further to this, I have doubts as to the validity of the evidence you have presented regarding your property within the local catchment (i.e. s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End) and the long term residential address recorded on OneSchool for your family (i.e. s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest). Investigative outcomes have revealed:
 - s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End, is a small 2-bedroom unit with one car space, purchased in s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest in the name of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest.
 - s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest is located in a residential area on a one-acre block and is very s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest.
 - s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest This property is jointly owned in the name of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest and s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest purchased in s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest prior to building of the very large family home.
 - s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest is a long-term family home, being the only address recorded on OneSchool for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest.
 - s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest is the address you informed the school of as your workplace, that being your own business. Further to this, you advised the school that this is your parents' house, whom you have previously lived with long-term.
 - Sightings of two motor vehicles; s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest and s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest regularly parked at the premises of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest at the front of the house behind the closed gate:
 - You initially provided no documents for motor vehicle registration or insurance to evidence your local address, rather advised that the vehicle you drive is registered in the business name or your parents name at s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest. However, you later provided registration and insurance documents for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest and s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest, sighting this as being the vehicle of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest. Additionally, you confirmed that you owned a s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest however it was written off in an accident in early s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest 2021.
 - Sightings of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest and s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest departing the premises on various weekday mornings, in the vehicle s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest with the children in their s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest State School uniform.
 - s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest informed the school that he drives s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest to school each day departing early for extracurricular activities, before proceeding to s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest for work. However, there have been no sightings of your family departing the vicinity of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End, on school mornings.

Furthermore, the minimal documentation that you provided upon submission of the enrolment application, including low electricity for a family of four and minimal nominated contents insurance, support my belief that your family are continuing to reside at s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest. It is my belief that you are presenting evidence that is intentionally designed to mislead our determination of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest principal place of residence to gain enrolment via local catchment.

5. As stated within the school's EMP, I reserve the right to undertake an audit or conduct an investigation at any time to ensure compliance with the EMP requirements; false or misleading statements or assertions amount to an offence and will have impact on an application for enrolment.
6. I am satisfied that there is no other relevant provision of the school's EMP which would apply to deem s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest eligible for enrolment at the school.
7. There is currently no spare capacity to accept out of catchment enrolments.

Reasons for my preliminary view

I have formed my preliminary view for the following reasons:

- To enrol at Brisbane State High School an applicant must be eligible in accordance with the school's EMP;
- False or misleading statements of assertions amount to an offence and will have impact on an application for enrolment;
- No other part of the school's EMP applies so as to render s.47(3) eligible to be enrolled;
- Accordingly, s.47(3) is not eligible to enrol at the school.

You may respond to this preliminary view by making a written submission to me, no later than seven days after receiving this letter.

If no submission is received, my preliminary view will be treated as the final decision and no further notice will be provided.

If a submission is received, I will consider the submission and make a final decision. A final decision notice will be provided to you to confirm the outcome as soon as is practicable.

We feel there is no requirement to update student residence information through out the school years. Even if s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest is eligible to enrol to s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest state high school, the application will be treated as out of catchment. As the family business is located at s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest all the incoming letter and accounts for accountant onsite will ease the pain of lost communications.

Secondly, Brisbane south secondary state college only place Brisbane State high school catchment student in priority enrolment if the student reside from 2018 for 2022 enrolment which does not apply to us.

I refer to my preliminary view letter dated 3 November in relation to the enrolment application for your daughter, s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest at Brisbane State High School ('the school'). Thank you for your response. I have considered the information that you submitted on 9 November 2021 with the school's response outlined below.

Enrolment Management Plans (EMPs) are developed by the Department of Education and Training and it is my obligation as the Executive Principal to implement and administer the EMP. Our Enrolment Management Plan was reviewed by the Department as the school is over capacity as families decide they want their child/ren to attend our school and therefore move from other areas of Brisbane to our local catchment. We acknowledge we are a great school; however, we are required to tightly manage enrolments at our school.

When you first approached our school, we were clear in informing you that our school was currently over capacity and that the demand for enrolment far exceeds the positions available in each year level. There was also reference made to the statement that, "parents considering enrolling their child at BSHS must understand that an application for enrolment does not guarantee confirmation of a place".

As has been previously communicated to you, the school requires the provision of documentary evidence to sufficiently demonstrate that the address stated on the enrolment application is the student's principal place of residence. The issue of whether a residence is a student's principal place of residence will be determined at my discretion, with the relevance and weight of each factor dependent on the individual circumstances of each case. After consideration of your existing enrolment package and the additional documentation that you provided, further findings of fact are outlined below.

My final decision

I have decided that s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest is not entitled to enrolment at Brisbane State High School in accordance with section Chapter 8, Part 3 of the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006 (the Act), and in accordance with the school's Enrolment Management Plan (School EMP).

Final decision materials considered

In making my decision, I considered the following material:

- Your application for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest for Local Catchment Area, dated s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest 2021;
- Statutory declaration made by s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest on s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest 2021 regarding the residential address of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest

- Preceding communication with our Enrolments Officer, by way of local catchment pre-enrolment interview on s.47(3)(b) 2021 and, telephone conversation thereafter;
- The effective School Enrolment Management Plan (School EMP) and catchment map for Brisbane State High School;
- The Department's School EMP procedure and operational guidelines;
- Chapter 8, Part 3 of the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006 (the Act);
- OneSchool records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest regarding residential address, enrolment activity, and other relevant information;
- Outcomes from an ongoing investigation that independently assess and validate information that you supplied in your enrolment application;
- Property Data from RP Data Professional; and,
- Your response to my preliminary view letter dated 9 November 2021.

Reasons for my final decision

As stated within our current Enrolment Management Plan, parents who seek to enrol their child at the school will need to fully demonstrate that the student's principal place of residence is genuinely within the catchment area. Current proof of residency at the address indicated on the enrolment application must be provided.

As per my preliminary findings on 3 November 2021:

- I acknowledge that s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest owns a residence within our catchment boundaries; this does not support the determination of s.47(3)(b) principal place of residence as per enrolment eligibility requirements.
- I retain the belief that you consciously provided selected documentary evidence and misleading information within the enrolment application with the intended effect of meeting enrolment eligibility requirements.
- OneSchool records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest show her residential details as s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest active from s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest 2014 – updated to s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End, 4101, on s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest 2021.
- OneSchool records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest show that she is a future student with s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest State High School and s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest State High School. It is reasonable to assume that you have undertaken these additional enrolment processes, as you are not eligible for local catchment enrolment at Brisbane State High School.

The EMP specifically states that, as Executive Principal, I "reserve the right to undertake an audit or conduct an investigation at any time to ensure compliance with the requirements under this Enrolment Management Plan and an entitlement to enrol". Temporarily residing, leasing and/or owning a property within our catchment is not the same as being able to demonstrate a student's principal place of residence, as per our current EMP. The evidence you have submitted provided does not assist in determining that Viena is eligible to enrol at our school through local area catchment.

While your submission shows that you own a 2-bedroom property within our catchment boundaries (i.e. s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End), you have not been able to sufficiently prove this address as s.47(3)(b) principal place of residence as per our current Enrolment Management Plan. I have been consistent in explaining that, as the Executive Principal, I am required to undertake stringent consideration of all applications to be considered for enrolment via local catchment, and I do not make such decisions lightly.

In considering additional information you have provided on 9 November in response to the opportunity to forward evidencing documentation to meet eligibility for a local enrolment application and, based on the balance of probability, my final decision is that I am unable to offer enrolment for s.47(3)(b) via local catchment. No other part of the School's Enrolment Management Plan applies so as to render s.47(3)(b) eligible for enrolment.

Pursuant to sections 156(1) and 171 of the Act and in accordance with the School EMP, I have made the decision that s.47(3)(b) - Contra is not entitled to enrolment at Brisbane State High School for the following reasons:

- Section 156(1) of the Act provides that, "Subject to subsections (1A), (2) and (3), the principal must enrol the prospective student at the school if the prospective student is entitled under this Act to be enrolled at the school". Based on the material before me, I am not satisfied that s.47(3)(b) - Contra is entitled under the Act to be enrolled at the school.
- Section 171 of the Act and the School EMP provides that a person is entitled to be enrolled if their principal place of residence is in the school's catchment area. I am not satisfied based on the material before me that s.47(3)(b) - Contra principal place of residence is within the school's catchment area.
- Accordingly, it is my decision that s.47(3)(b) - Contra is not entitled to enrolment at Brisbane State High School, as she does not reside in the catchment and none of the other criteria for enrolment that apply to those who reside outside the catchment area would have applied in their circumstances.
- There is currently no spare capacity to accept out of catchment enrolments.

The School EMP provides that my decision is final. There is no internal review available of my decision.

I recalled s.47(3)(b) - from when she attended for a pre enrolment interview for her daughter s.47(3)(b) towards the end of Term s.47(3)(b) she was a current student at s.47(3)(b) in s.47(3)(b) and was wanting to enroll to BSHS for s.47(3)(b) 2020.

I recall s.47(3)(b) - had advised that she recently purchased the unit, was separated from her husband and had moved into the 2BR Unit with her two children.

A staff member who wishes to remain anonymous, was privy to the enrolment application and conversation and had close connections in close proximity to the LCA address provided on the application, s.47(3)(b) - Contrary West End. In the weeks preceding the interview with s.47(3)(b) - for her daughters perspective enrolment, the staff member advised that she had not observed such a family to be living in the LCA unit complex as per the application, nor had she seen any evidence of a motor vehicle parked in the allocated car park for the address. In fact the staff member advised that there was a 2 seater couch located in the car park, that was believed to be brand new, wrapped in plastic and remained there for several weeks.

A spot check was carried out at the families previous address s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to at which time the motor vehicle s.47(3)(b) details of which were included within the application (for proof of residency) was parked in the driveway at the previous s.47(3)(b) - address.

A further morning visit to the address confirmed the s.47(3)(b) student to be in attendance at the s.47(3)(b) - address, she was observed to exit from the driveway gate of the premises, wearing a s.47(3)(b) uniform, carrying a school bag and a drink in her hands and board vehicle s.47(3)(b) a s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to P wagon.

As this was towards the end of Term 4 an outcome was not provided, rather was to be provided at the beginning of the new school year prior to commencement Term 1 2020, however at no time did Ms s.47(3)(b) follow up on the status of the daughters application. Due to the large volume of work both at the end of year and start of year with enrolments and with no further follow up from the family no further communication was had, in regard to the s.47(3)(b) 2020 application.

Once the selective entry process was finalized and the student s.47(3)(b) was unsuccessful and prior to the enrolment interview on s.47(3)(b) 2020 for LCA, further investigations commenced.

Desktop searches were carried out and One School records confirmed the address for both student and parents as unchanged from s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Pub and at no time a record of moving to West End.

RPD showed that both addresses s.47(3)(b) - Contrary West End and s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Pub were still currently owned by both s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to and s.47(3)(b) - Contra

I refer to the recent application to enrol your son, s.47(3)(b) at Brisbane State High School ('the school').

My preliminary view

This letter is to advise you that I have formed a preliminary view that s.47(3)(b) is not eligible to enrol at Brisbane State High School.

Preliminary material considered

In considering this enrolment application, I considered the following preliminary material:

- Your application for s.47(3)(b) for Local Catchment Area and for Sporting Selective Entry s.47(3)(b) - Contra s.47(3)(b) - Contra enrolment, dated s.47(3)(b) 2020;
- Preceding communication with our Enrolments Officer, by way of local catchment pre-enrolment interview on s.47(3)(b) 2020;
- The effective School Enrolment Management Plan (School EMP) and catchment map for Brisbane State High School;
- The Department's School EMP procedure and operational guidelines;
- Chapter 8, Part 3 of the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006 (the Act);
- OneSchool records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest regarding residential address, enrolment activity, and other relevant information;
- Outcomes from an ongoing investigation that independently assess and validate information that you supplied in your enrolment application; and,
- Property Data from RP Data Professional.

My preliminary findings of fact

In consideration of the preliminary material, I made the following findings of fact:

1. OneSchool records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest show that he is currently enrolled at s.47(3)(b) - C State School, and has been since year s.47(3)(b). This school is not within the boundaries of our catchment area, nor is it a recognised feeder for our local area enrolments. This raises doubts as to the validity of your application for in-catchment enrolment.
2. Furthermore, OneSchool records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest show his residential and postal details as:
 - s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest, active from s.47(3)(b) - then;
 - s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest, effective s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest then;
 - A change of postal address to s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest (residential address) effective s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest

OneSchool records show both parents residential address as s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest with no change of address since s.47(3)(b). It is reasonable to assume that if s.47(3)(b) principal place of residence had changed you would have further advised s.47(3)(b) - C State School of both his and your change of residential address.

3. You have provided evidence that demonstrates that you have recently purchased a property within the catchment; s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End, 4101. This is not the same as being able to demonstrate, via submitted evidence that s.47(3)(b) principal place of residence is within our catchment boundaries. It is reasonable to assume that you have nominated the property at s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End, 4101, for the purpose of Local Catchment Area enrolment.
 4. Further to this, I have doubts as to the validity of the evidence you have presented regarding your other residence - s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest and s.47(3)(b) being the sole occupant of the large family home, while s.47(3)(b) your s.47(3)(b) daughter and s.47(3)(b) reside in the much smaller 2 bedroom unit in West End. Investigative outcomes have revealed:
 - s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End, is a 2-bedroom unit with one car space, purchased s.47(3)(b) s.47(3)(b) in joint names of both parents s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest.
 - s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest in joint names of both parents s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest.
 - s.47(3)(b) is a long-term family home, being the address sighted on the birth certificate for s.47(3)(b).
 - Sightings of three motor vehicles regularly parked at the premises of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest either in garage, driveway or roadside at front of house:
 - Vehicle s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest wagon, registered for commercial use; you provided an RACQ insurance document that states the usual location to be in a garage at West End;
 - Vehicle s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest.
 - Vehicle s.47(3)(b) s.47(3)(b) regularly displaying L Plates.
 - Sightings of all s.47(3)(b) members of the family departing the premises on various weekday mornings, in the abovementioned vehicles, with the children in school uniforms, teenage girl in s.47(3)(b) - State High School and young boy in s.47(3)(b) - State School uniform.
- Furthermore, I have been provided with statements that support my belief that your family are continuing to reside at s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest and that you are presenting evidence that is intentionally designed to mislead our determination of s.47(3)(b) principal place of residence to gain enrolment via local catchment.
5. As stated within the school's EMP, I reserve the right to undertake an audit or conduct an investigation at any time to ensure compliance with the EMP requirements; false or misleading statements or assertions amount to an offence and will have impact on an application for enrolment.
 6. I acknowledge that prior to your pre enrolment interview for your local application you had also lodged unsuccessful applications for s.47(3)(b) for selective entry including both swimming and cross country.
 7. I am satisfied that there is no other relevant provision of the school's EMP which would apply to deem s.47(3)(b) eligible for enrolment at the school.
 8. There is currently no spare capacity to accept out of catchment enrolments.

Reasons for my preliminary view

I have formed my preliminary view for the following reasons:

- To enrol at Brisbane State High School an applicant must be eligible in accordance with the school's EMP;
- False or misleading statements or assertions amount to an offence and will have impact on an application for enrolment;
- No other part of the school's EMP applies so as to render s.47(3)(b) eligible to be enrolled.
- Accordingly s.47(3)(b) is not eligible to enrol at the school.

You may respond to this preliminary view by making a written submission to me, no later than seven days after receiving this letter.

If no submission is received, my preliminary view will be treated as the final decision and no further notice will be provided.

If a submission is received, I will consider the submission and make a final decision. A final decision notice will be provided to you to confirm the outcome as soon as is practicable.



My preliminary view

This letter is to advise you that I have formed a preliminary view that s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest is not eligible to enrol at Brisbane State High School.

Preliminary material considered

In considering the enrolment application, I considered the following preliminary material:

- Your application for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest for Local Catchment Area enrolment, dated s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest 2021 and for Selective Entry s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest enrolment, dated s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest 2021;
- Preceding communication with our Enrolments Office, by way of local catchment pre-enrolment interview on s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest 2021 and telephone communication;
- The effective School Enrolment Management Plan (School EMP) and catchment map for Brisbane State High School;
- The Department's School EMP procedure and operational guidelines;
- Chapter 8, Part 3 of the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006 (the Act);
- OneSchool records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest regarding residential address, enrolment activity, and other relevant information;
- Outcomes from an ongoing investigation that independently assess and validate information that you supplied in your enrolment application; and,
- Property Data from RP Data Professional.

My preliminary findings of fact

In consideration of the preliminary material, I made the following findings of fact:

1. OneSchool records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest show that she is currently enrolled at s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest State School, and has been since year s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest. This school is not within the boundaries of our catchment area, nor is it a recognised feeder for our local area enrolments. This raises doubts as to the validity of your application for in-catchment enrolment.
2. Furthermore, OneSchool records for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest show her residential and postal details as:
 - s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest active from s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest 2015, with no change since s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest 2013;

OneSchool records showed both parents residential address as s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest. s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest change was made to OneSchool records on s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest 2021, with the address for s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest (Mother) updated to s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End, 4101.

s.47(3)(b) - (Father) address remains unchanged at s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest. Additionally, OneSchool Records note s.47(3)(b) resides with student, s.47(3)(b) - C at this address.

OneSchool records show the siblings of s.47(3)(b) - also noted on the application, as follows:

- s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest at s.47(3)(b) State High School s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest resides at s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest with no change of address since s.47(3)(b) - 2013.
- s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest State School, effective s.47(3)(b) - 2021: resides at s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End. OneSchool records show s.47(3)(b) - Co was previously at s.47(3)(b) State School from year s.47(3)(b) - Co left s.47(3)(b) - Co 2021; resided at s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest
- s.47(3)(b) - Co - Graduated s.47(3)(b) - State High School in s.47(3) resided at s.47(3) s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest

In addition, OneSchool records note that s.47(3)(b) - C has a future enrolment at s.47(3)(b) - State High School, effective s.47(3)(b) - 2021.

It is reasonable to assume that if s.47(3) principal place of residence had changed you would have further advised s.47(3)(b) - State School of both her and your change of residential address, as you did with your younger daughter s.47(3)(b) - Co. It is also reasonable to assume that you have enrolled s.47(3) as a future student at s.47(3)(b) - State High School with your address of s.47(3) s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest to meet eligibility for in-catchment enrolment within the framework of their School EMP. This raises doubts as to the validity of your application for an in-catchment enrolment at Brisbane State High School for your daughter, s.47(3).

3. You have provided evidence that demonstrates that you have recently leased a property within the catchment; s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End, 4101. This is not the same as being able to demonstrate, via submitted evidence that s.47(3) principal place of residence is within our catchment boundaries. It is reasonable to assume that you have nominated the property at s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End, 4101, for the purpose of Local Catchment Area enrolment. Investigative outcomes have revealed:

- s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest West End, is a one-bedroom small unit with no allocated car space, in a small complex of five units;
- The lease was taken out after the unsuccessful outcome of the Selective Entry Application, dated s.47(3)(b) - C 2020, was communicated;
- The lease provided is for the period 15/5/2021 to 12/11/2021 for \$290 per week.

4. Further to this, I have doubts as to the validity of the evidence you have presented regarding your other residence s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest that s.47(3)(b) resides at this long-term address and family home, with two of your children who attend s.47(3)(b) State High School and s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest that s.47(3)(b) resides in the much smaller leased one-bedroom unit in West End, with two of the children who attend s.47(3)(b) State School and s.47(3)(b) - State School. Investigative outcomes have revealed:

- s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest
Joint names of both parents s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest
- s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest is a long-term family home, being the OneSchool address since s.47(3) enrolled at school in s.47(3)
- Sightings of three motor vehicles regularly parked at the premises of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest early on weekday mornings, either in garage, front lawn, driveway, behind closed gates, or roadside at front of house:
 - Vehicle s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest sedan, you provided an RACQ insurance document that states the usual location to be in a garage at West End;
 - Vehicle s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest
 - Vehicle s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest

- Sightings at the premises of s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest of all s.47 members of the family, on various weekday mornings; departing the premises in the abovementioned vehicles with the children in school uniforms; walking to school in s.47(3)(b) State School uniforms and, hanging washing on the clothesline.

It is reasonable to assume that you are presenting evidence that is intentionally designed to mislead our determination of s.47(3) principal place of residence to gain enrolment via local catchment.

5. Furthermore, telephone conversations with s.47(3)(b) whereby she advised that she had taken out the lease to enable s.47(3) to enrol at the school, as she insists this is the school she wishes to attend. s.47(3)(b) advised that the children who attend school in South Brisbane will continue to reside at s.47(3)(b) and, the children who attend school at s.47(3)(b) will reside at South Brisbane. s.47(3)(b) advised that she would consider moving her youngest daughter to s.47(3) s.47(3) School, if this would assist the application for s.47(3)(b) - at Brisbane State High School.
6. As stated within the school's EMP, I reserve the right to undertake an audit or conduct an investigation at any time to ensure compliance with the EMP requirements; false or misleading statements or assertions amount to an offence and will have impact on an application for enrolment.
7. I acknowledge that prior to your pre-enrolment interview for your local application you had also lodged unsuccessful applications for s.47(3) for Selective Entry s.47(3)(b) - Contrary to Public Interest s.47(3).
8. I am satisfied that there is no other relevant provision of the school's EMP which would apply to deem s.47(3) eligible for enrolment at the school.
9. There is currently no spare capacity to accept out of catchment enrolments.

Reasons for my preliminary view

I have formed my preliminary view for the following reasons:

- To enrol at Brisbane State High School an applicant must be eligible in accordance with the school's EMP;
- False or misleading statements or assertions amount to an offence and will have impact on an application for enrolment;
- No other part of the school's EMP applies so as to render s.47(3) eligible to be enrolled.
- Accordingly, s.47(3) is not eligible to enrol at the school.

You may respond to this preliminary view by making a written submission to me, no later than seven days after receiving this letter.

If no submission is received, my preliminary view will be treated as the final decision and no further notice will be provided.

If a submission is received, I will consider the submission and make a final decision. A final decision notice will be provided to you to confirm the outcome as soon as is practicable.
