Thank you for your email of 9 August 2013 highlighting your concerns about the continued use of Brisbane North Institute of TAFE (BNIT) Redcliffe campus by students with special needs.

Firstly, I acknowledge your concerns about the future needs for your daughter who is currently studying at TAFE. Our ongoing goal for TAFE in Queensland is to produce real results for students with a focus on high quality training. At this stage, no decisions have been made about the location of TAFE on the Redcliffe Peninsula. However, I can confirm that a consultation process has commenced regarding the education and training services in the vicinity of the Redcliffe State High School, with a number of options being explored.

Part of exploring options is giving consideration to relocating TAFE to more central premises in Redcliffe to enhance the ability of BNIT to provide more responsive training programs to the local community.

Regarding the future of the course in which your daughter is currently enrolled, I have been advised by BNIT that the Institute is unable to identify the particular course based on the information you have provided in your email. You are welcome to contact me again or you may wish to contact Ms Lynne Foley, Institute Director, BNIT, by email at lynne.foley@tafe.qld.gov.au or on telephone 3258 5118 with this additional information. I must advise you, however, that due to privacy provisions, should your daughter be over 18 years of age, her written permission would need to be provided to enable specific information in relation to this matter to be passed on to you.

I can assure you that the Institute will continue to work closely with students, teachers and the community regarding the future delivery of training in Redcliffe. Once a decision on the location has been reached, every effort will be made to minimise disruptions to students to ensure they continue to receive ongoing, high quality training.

As advised, should you require any further information, you may wish to contact Ms Foley, as per the contact details outlined above.

Again, thank you for writing to me on this matter and I hope this information is of assistance to you. I wish your daughter all the best with her ongoing study.



Dear colleague,

I am writing to you today to inform you that a consultation process is currently underway to realign education and training services in the vicinity of Redcliffe State High School to maximize the use of the Department's local land and buildings.

This process has been prompted by the need for Redcliffe State High School to expand its classrooms and learning areas to accommodate the Year 7 students who will join the school in 2015.

Redcliffe Special School is currently located adjacent to the main campus of Redcliffe State High School and will need to find new premises to allow for the increase of the high school's student numbers. Brisbane North Institute of TAFE's Redcliffe campus has been identified as an ideal location for the special school.

There are a number of options for the future TAFE presence in the Redcliffe area. Brisbane North Institute of TAFE could operate out of commercial premises centrally located within Redcliffe to provide responsive training to the local community. Alternatively co-location on the grounds of Redcliffe State High School could provide similar training experiences as well as ongoing opportunities for school-based training pathways.

The Infrastructure Services area of the Department is currently undertaking a consultation process. This process will involve all interested employees at BNIT and our students at Redcliffe campus, along with the schools, community groups and government stakeholders.

I will advise you once I have the time and date for the relevant consultation forums.

During this time, I know you will continue to focus on providing the best experience for our students and to remain positive as we work through this consultation process. We will look for the best way to provide training opportunities in the Redcliffe area.

All students currently undertaking studies at the Redcliffe campus will be able to complete their current course of study. Students wanting to enrol in programs in Redcliffe for 2014 are still able to do so, and I ask that you encourage them to study with us.

My executive and I will continue to provide you with information about this consultation process as it comes to hand.

I remind you that any enquiries from local media regarding this issue are to be directed to my office.

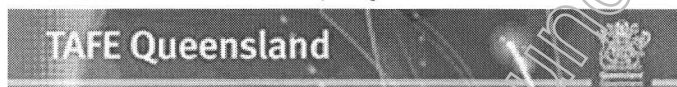

Feel reassured but concerned about price for training, whether students can afford it and whether we will still have a job.

Many questions were asked about how the new premises will be fitted out, access, timing, and communication.

Wanted to know what the communication can be right now - it was reinforced that students will be able to continue their programs, can enrol for 2014, and that the programs offered across BMR will be finalised within the next 3-4 weeks with appropriate communication with all employees.

Community consultation Redcliffe education and training - 38 present

Yvette D'Ath Member for Petrie and her Chief of Staff Stirling Hinchliffe were present.

Members of the community centred out of their comments on potential loss of programs particularly for young and mature age people with a disability, and on literacy and numeracy programs. They were concerned that oping into

commercial premises was a signal that TAFE services would leave then Redcliffe area. While they could see the sense in the campus being used for special education, they asked many questions about the type of location, transport accessibility and disability access.

The majority of the session was spent with questions regarding programs, funding by government of training now and in the future, how programs are taught and assessed. Many people were seeking absolute guarantees of provision of certain programs into the future. No guarantees were given. Programs run according to levels of demand within the community. Many wanted more marketing of programs, having a view that this would ensure higher demand.

The session was courteous, and individuals had time and space to provide their opinions. There seemed to be a certain level of resignation to the possible outcome of TAFE moving to new premises, rather than acceptance.

Thank you for the opportunity to meet yesterday to discuss the Year 7 to Secondary facilities at Redcliffe SHS.

As discussed on the day, DETE is unable to relocate Redcliffe Special School to the Redcliffe Campus of BNIT for the start of the 2015 school year.

There is a requirement for DETE to build additional assets than initially anticipated for Redcliffe Special School which will require the Special School to be housed in relocatable buildings from mid to late 2014 onwards which would not be a good outcome for a special school.

As a result DETE believes the following proposal will meet Redcliffe SHS Year 7 to Secondary requirements for 2015 until Redcliffe Special can be handed over which is anticipated for 2016.

- On the site of the old hall build a 2 storey 8 space general learning block with flexible learning area and associated spaces (collaborative area) and staff facilities
- Refurbish 4 x general learning areas in Block F closest to the old hall (includes repairing white ant damage, replacing windows)
- Create a covered outdoor area between the proposed 8 space building and Block F
- Enhance outdoor area between the 4 classrooms being refurbished and the fenceline.
- Undertake a master plan to bring the SHS and Special School sites together
- Replacement hall facility to be built in 2016 in line with the master plan – this could occur earlier if the Special School vacate during 2015.

Separate issue to Year 7 to Secondary – there is currently a classroom deficiency on-site. DETE has approved 2 x 2 classroom space secondary relocatable buildings to be provided for the start of the 2014 school year. They may not be ready until the start of Term 2 due to the difficulties with locations.

Hi media team,

I just have a few questions relating to Redcliffe State High School, Redcliffe Special School and the Redcliffe campus of Brisbane North Institute of TAFE.

BACKGROUND: I believe there was a meeting in early August regarding a proposal for Redcliffe Special School to move to the existing BNIT campus on Klingner Rd in the middle of 2014. I understand this will give Redcliffe High the opportunity to move into the Special School premises at the start of 2015, which is when Year 7 pupils will become part of the high school – it all makes sense. But I could be wrong, so please feel free to clarify anything if I'm not 100 per cent correct.

QUESTIONS:

1. Is there a proposal for Redcliffe Special School to move to the TAFE campus and Redcliffe High to move into the Redcliffe Special School area? A consultation process has begun to maximise the use of DETE land and buildings in the vicinity of Redcliffe State High School.
2. What are the details of this proposal? And timeframes? As schools in the area continue to grow, Redcliffe State High School will also need to grow to accommodate Year 7 from 2015. Redcliffe Special School is currently adjacent to the main campus of the high school. Relocating the Redcliffe Special School to the Redcliffe campus of Brisbane North Institute of TAFE would allow for the current service to expand to cater for students in the earlier years. The department is identifying suitable locations for the future presence of TAFE in the area with an aim to have a new location ready for the 2014 school year.
3. Why are the moves being looked at? Is it to accommodate Year 7s as part of high school? The Redcliffe Peninsula continues to grow and it is vital that Redcliffe State High School and the Special School are prepared for growth, especially as the transition of Year 7 into high school is approaching. Furthermore,

the Redcliffe campus of BNIT is not being used to its full capacity. This proposal allows for the education and training facilities to all be used to their full potential.

4. Will any work need to be done to the BNIT campus to make it suitable for the special school? (If the proposal goes ahead of course). **If the proposal proceeds the BNIT campus will require minor changes and the parcel of land adjacent to the school, owned by the Department, would require new buildings for classroom accommodation.**
5. If the plan does go ahead, after the special school moves to BNIT campus, will any work be needed to the existing special school campus to accommodate Redcliffe High School students? **If the proposal proceeds the special school campus will require minor changes to accommodate secondary school classrooms.**
6. If the plan goes ahead, will Redcliffe still have a BNIT campus? If so, where? If the proposal proceeds BNIT will still have a TAFE campus in Redcliffe. The TAFE campus is likely to be in a commercial lease. The facility would be fitted out to meet the programs delivered by the TAFE campus in Redcliffe.

Thank you for your email of 9 August 2013 highlighting your concerns about the continued use of Brisbane North Institute of TAFE (BNIT) Redcliffe campus by students with special needs. I apologise for the delay in responding.

Firstly, I understand your concerns about the future needs for your daughter who is currently studying at TAFE. Our ongoing goal for TAFE in Queensland is to produce real results for students with a focus on high quality training. At this stage, no decisions have been made about the location of TAFE on the Redcliffe Peninsula. However, I can confirm that a consultation process has commenced about the education and training services in the vicinity of the Redcliffe State High School, with a number of options being explored.

Part of exploring options is giving consideration to relocating TAFE to more central premises in Redcliffe to enhance the ability of BNIT to provide more responsive training programs to the local community.


