Department of Education Additional Conditions of Contract

(Purchases up to \$250,000 ex GST)

The following Department of Education additional contract conditions apply to the Contract made on acceptance of the Supplier's Offer by the Customer, subject to applicable terms and conditions specified in the Request for Quote issued.

Blue Cards

A1. The Supplier must ensure that its officers, employees, agents and other persons involved with the supply of the Goods and/or Services under this Contract hold valid Blue Cards where required by law under the Working with Children (Risk Management and Screening) Act 2000 (Qld) prior to conducting any Services that involve contact with children under eighteen (18) years of age.

Child-related services

- A2. Where the Supplier provides child-related services:
 - a) The Supplier must comply with <u>National Principles for Child Safe Organisations</u> (<u>NPCSO</u>) to demonstrate their leadership and commitment to child safety and wellbeing.
 - b) If requested by the Customer, the Supplier must within Business Days of such request produce documentary evidence to demonstrate its compliance with NPCSO to the Customer's satisfaction.

Entering department sites

A3. Where entry to Customer's Sites is required the Supplier's Personnel must not enter Site/s without firstly presenting to the Customer's office / reception / security desk to gain permission to enter the Site and/or deliver Goods to the Site. This includes deliveries to school departments, tuckshops, uniform shops, book shops or Outside School Hours Care facilities.

Criminal History Checks

A4. Upon the reasonable request of the Customer at any time during the Contract Term, the Supplier must conduct and provide to the Customer an original or certified copy of the result of a Criminal History Check or other check required by the Customer for Personnel involved in the supply of Deliverables under the Contract.
