New multi-purpose hall for Freshwater State School

Delivering new facilities to support teaching and learning

The Department of Education is delivering a new \$14 million multi-purpose hall for Freshwater State School.

The new hall will provide the school with a weather-proof indoor space for school assemblies, stage performances, concerts and indoor sporting activities such as basketball and netball.

The hall design and landscaping plan has not been finalised, however there are a number of trees that will be required to be removed. The decision to remove trees is influenced by the building platform, constructability and the existing condition of the trees. All efforts will be made to reduce the number of trees being removed.

Replanting and landscaping of the area will be undertaken following construction completion.

The Freshwater State School concept site plan is included overleaf and shows the site location of the new multi-purpose hall.

Project scope (funded)

The proposed development will include:

- office
- control room
- small equipment store room
- stage
- 1 × prop store room
- 1 × multi-purpose sports court
- foyer
- multi-purpose room
- landscaping, including replanting.
- kitchen
- data and comms centre
- amenities
- large equipment store room

Next steps

While the hall design is being finalised, early works will begin in the next few weeks, which will include soil testing, surveying, project meetings and the removal of the existing structure. The project will begin construction in the coming weeks and is expected to be complete in mid-2025.
