### Discrete Communities Infrastructure program

#### **Improving schools for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities.**

The Discrete Communities Infrastructure (DCI) program is a Queensland Government program which provides funding to better plan, improve and build educational buildings and spaces by co-designing them with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities.

#### **The Lockhart River DCI co-design program**

For the past 12 months, the Lockhart River Aboriginal Shire Council members and key school community members have been working with the DCI team to co-design a master plan and identify key projects for Lockhart State School.

Next steps:

- **Seek community feedback on:**
  - The master plan.
  - A list of prioritised projects, categorised into Stage 1, Stage 2 and Stage 3 potential projects.
