The Discrete Communities Infrastructure (DCI) program is a Queensland Government program which provides funding to better plan, improve and build educational buildings and spaces by co-designing them with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities.

The Mapoon DCI co-design program

For the past 12 months, the Mapoon Aboriginal Shire Council members and key school community members have been working with the DCI team to co-design a master plan and identify key projects for Western Cape College – Mapoon Campus.

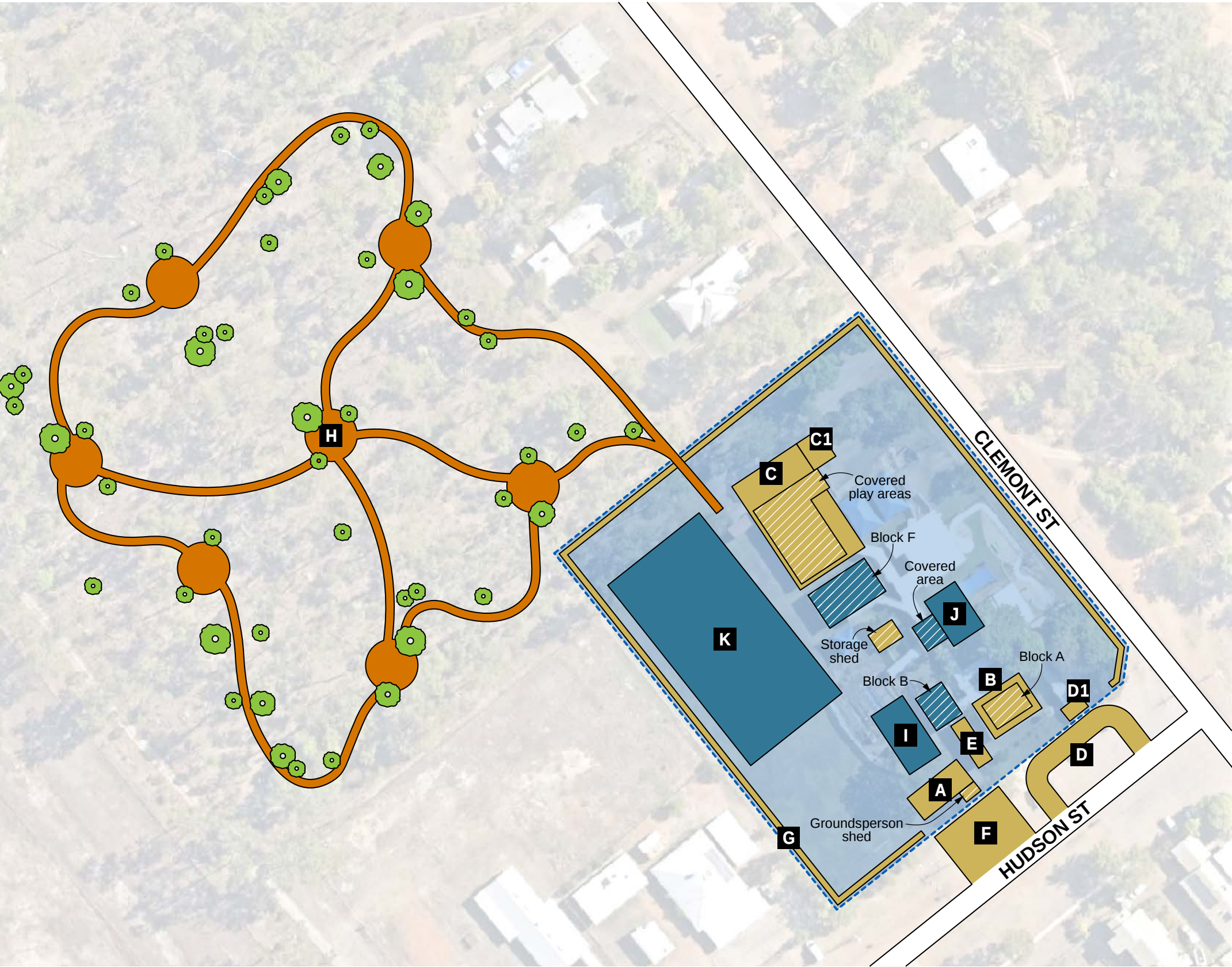
Next steps:

- G** New perimeter fence
- To be demolished:
 - Groundsperson shed
 - Existing Block A
 - Storage shed
 - Covered play areas

- H** New yarning circle, walkway and learning spaces

STAGE 3 POTENTIAL PROJECTS

- I** New classroom building
- J** New library/resource centre
- K** New football field, posts and irrigation

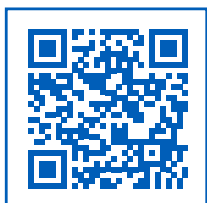
