The Discrete Communities Infrastructure (DCI) program is a Queensland Government program which provides funding to better plan, improve and build educational buildings and spaces by co-designing them with Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities.

### The Pompuraaw DCI co-design program

For the past 12 months, the Pompuraaw Aboriginal Shire Council members and key school community members have been working with the DCI team to co-design a master plan and identify key projects for Pompuraaw State School.


Next steps:
