A new special school for Central Logan (Berrinba)

Delivering new facilities to support teaching and learning

The Queensland Government is delivering a new special school for Central Logan (Berrinba). Early works have begun for Stage 1 and construction will commence before the end of 2025.

The new special school will be co-located next to Berrinba East State School on Queensland Government owned land. This new special school, and the new special school under construction in Logan Reserve, will help relieve enrolment demand on existing special schools in the area.

The new special school at Central Logan (Berrinba) will cater for primary aged students, with a staged introduction of year levels commencing from 2027. A concept site plan is included overleaf and shows the proposed site location of the new buildings.

A Ministerial Infrastructure Designation Amendment is proposed to seek town planning approval for Stage 2 and 3. The community are invited to have their say on the proposed Stage 2 and Stage 3 developments. If planning approval is received, the Queensland Government intends to complete construction of the proposed staff car park (Stage 2) in time for the school opening.

Stage 1 (funded)

- 2 two-storey buildings with 34 classrooms
- sporting and playing facilities
- two-storey administration building, including a resource and information centre and a tuckshop
- multi-purpose hall with specialist music and art spaces
- a central green space/playground

Stage 2 (funded)

- proposed staff car park.

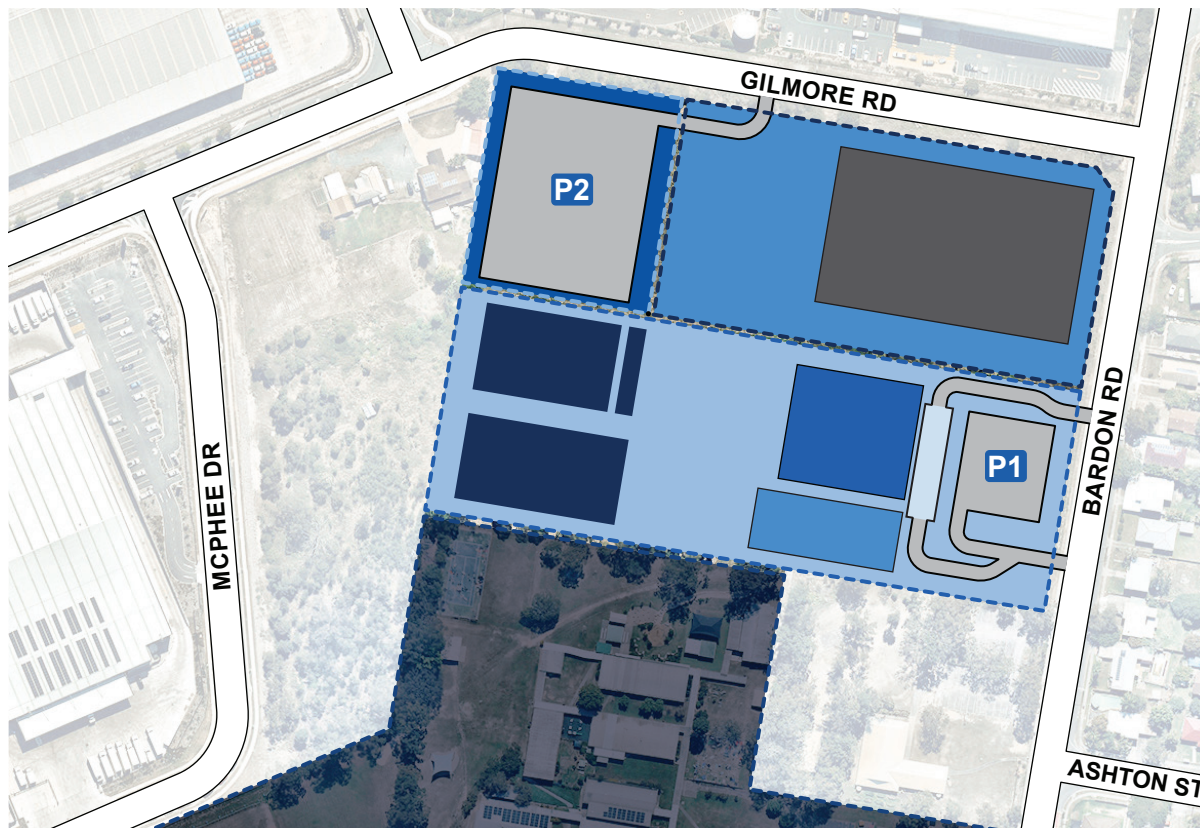
- storage and equipment sheds
- a car park at the Bardon Road frontage, including bus facilities and a drop-off/pick-up zone
- access from Bardon Road, within separate entry and exit
- retention of the existing forest play/garden on the western edge of the Berrinba East State School.

Stage 3 (unfunded)

- proposed future building/s.

Please note: Stage 1 and Stage 2 are funded, however Stage 3 is a planning exercise only and subject to the availability of funding in the future

Next steps

As part of the planning and approval process for Stage 2 and 3, the Queensland Government will consider the traffic, heritage, vegetation, acoustic and storm water impacts and mitigations. These outcomes will be used to develop the detailed design of the car park and future building. Before a final decision is made, a second round of formal community consultation will take place to inform the Ministerial Infrastructure Designation outlining further details, including final height and design.
