Procurement Savings Financial Years 2009 to 2020



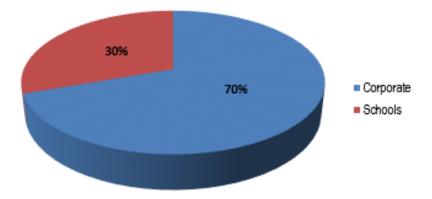

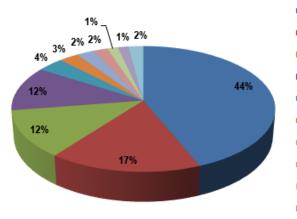

Sub-Category Spend Corporate & Schools 12 months (July 2019 - June 2020)



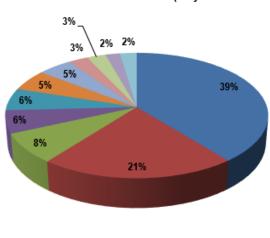

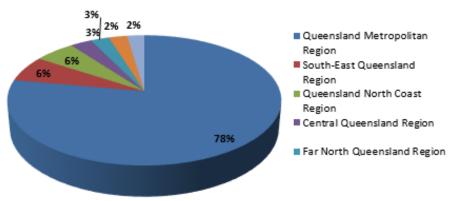

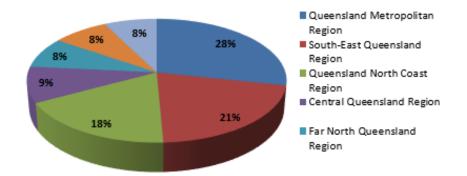

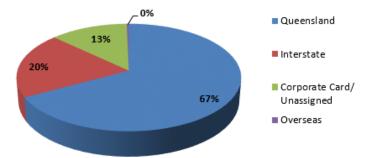

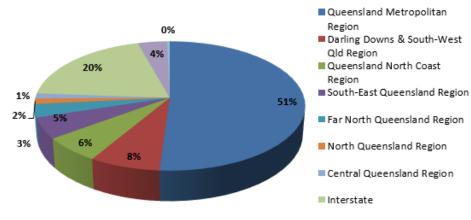

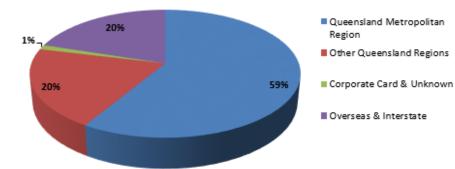

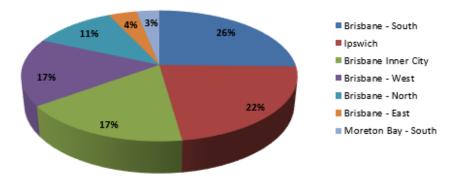

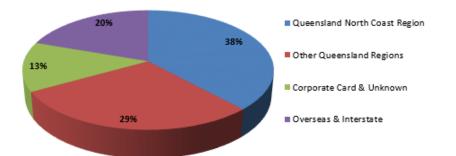

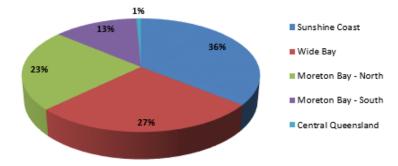

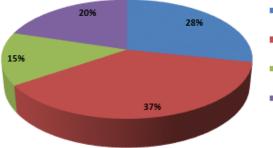

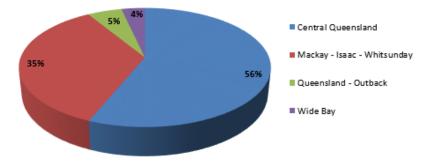

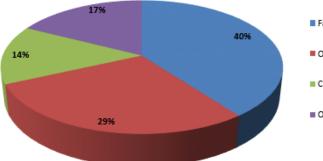

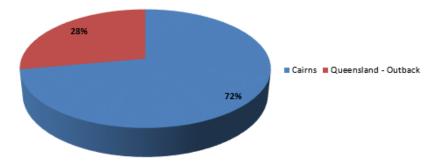

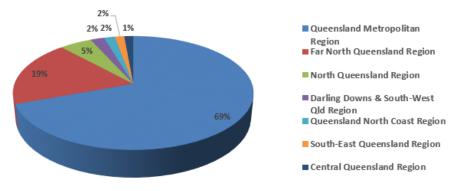

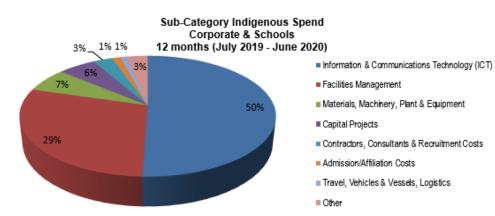

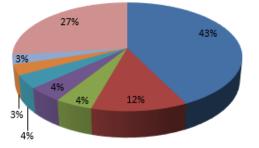
